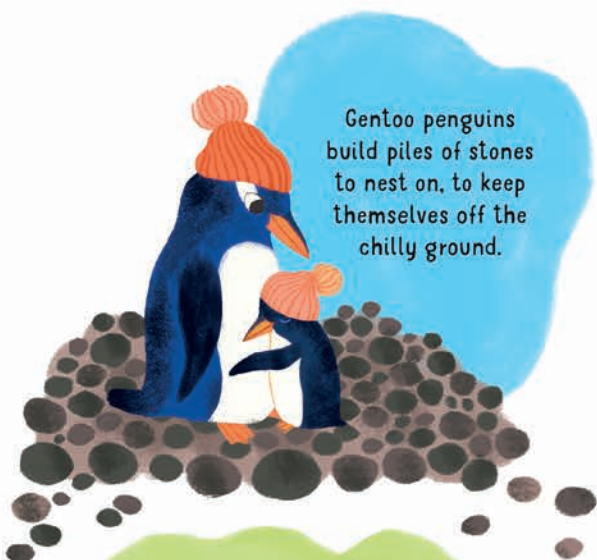

Gentoo penguins build piles of stones to nest on, to keep themselves off the chilly ground.

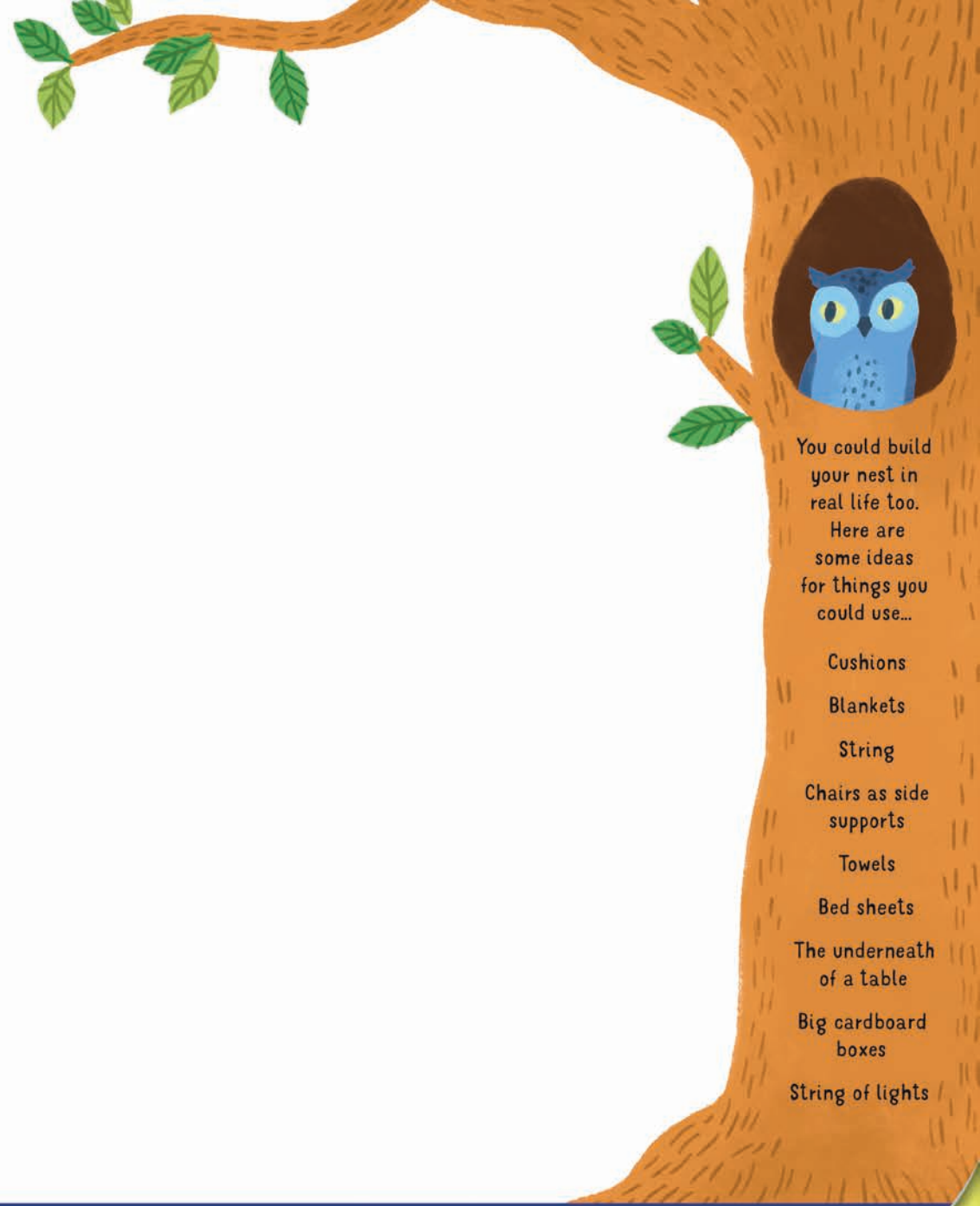


Blue tits line their tiny nests with soft feathers and moss.
