

Bulls and cows

A pen-and-paper game for two players






Both players secretly write down a three-digit number. All the digits must be different.





Take turns to guess each other's number, writing your guesses on another piece of paper. Then write next to each other's guesses how many 'bulls' and 'cows' there are.



a correct digit in the correct place

a correct digit in the wrong place

Example: Guess 1:

345

Guess 7: 267 BB


Guess 8: 268 BC

Guess 9: 287 BBB Two of these digits are correct, but in the wrong place.





The first to get three bulls, finding the secret number, is the winner.





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
