



Chocolate nests

For 12 nests you will need:

- A non-stick muffin tray with 12 holes
- 200g or 1 cup milk chocolate broken into chunks
- 100g or $\frac{1}{2}$ cup dark chocolate broken into chunks
- 50g or $\frac{1}{4}$ cup butter
- 2 tablespoons runny honey
- 100g (4 cups) corn flakes

If you use a cup for measuring, use the same cup for all the ingredients.



Stir with a wooden spoon.

1. Add the butter and honey to a large pan. Gently melt them over a low heat.



2. Turn the heat off and add the chocolate. Keep stirring until the chunks have melted.



3. Stir in the corn flakes until they are coated in the chocolate mixture.



Press down lightly with a spoon.

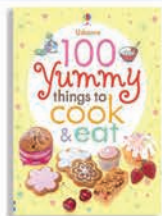
4. Spoon the mixture into the dips in the muffin sheet for nests.



5. Push three little chocolate eggs into the middle of each nest.



6. Chill the nests for one hour then, use a spoon to lift the nests out of the tray.



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
