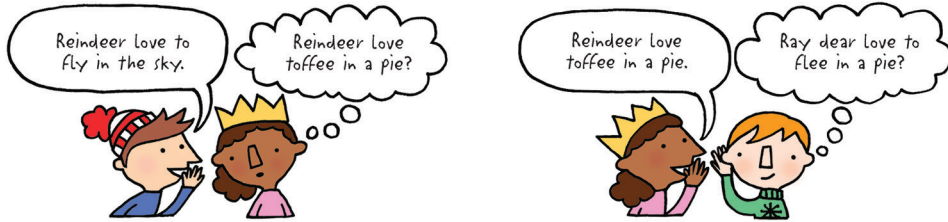


CHRISTMAS PARTY GAMES

CHRISTMAS WHISPERS

This game works best with lots of people. To play it, sit spaced out in a line.

1. The first person in the line very quietly whispers a Christmassy phrase to the person next to them. They only say it once.
2. That person whispers what they think they heard to the person on their other side.



3. The game continues until the phrase reaches the last person.
4. That person says out loud what they think the phrase is.



FROZEN SNOWMAN

In this game, everyone tries to make a 'snowman' move...

1. Choose someone to be the snowman. The snowman has to stay frozen still.
2. Everyone tries to make the snowman move. They can't touch him, but they can...
3. If the snowman moves, smiles or laughs, it's the end of the game. Whoever made the snowman move is the next snowman.



PASS THE SNOWBALL

For this game, you'll need a ball – the 'snowball' – and something that plays music. Before the game starts, choose someone to be in charge of starting and stopping the music.

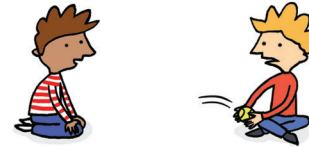
1. Everyone sits in a circle, and one person holds the snowball. The music starts, and the person with the snowball throws it to someone else.



2. That person quickly throws the snowball to someone else, and so on.



3. The game continues until the music is stopped. The person holding the ball is out.



4. The music starts again. The game continues, and the last person still playing is the winner.



CHRISTMAS HOPES AND DREAMS

In this game, take turns adding something to a list of presents, seeing how many you can remember in a row. When anyone forgets or repeats something, they're out of the game.



TIP: For a trickier variation, you could try thinking of things that start with the letters of the alphabet, starting with 'A'.
