

Cone decorations

178 Santa



1. To make a cone for the body, lay a plate on a piece of thick red paper and draw around it. Cut out the circle you have drawn, then cut it in half.



2. Bend one of the halves around to make a cone and glue it. While the glue is drying, cut a shape for Santa's hair and beard from a piece of white material.



3. Cut out a circle for the top of the hat. Then, cut a face from paper and glue it onto the beard. Draw eyes, cheeks and a mouth. Glue everything onto the cone.



4. Cut arms, hands, legs and boots from paper. Glue the hands onto the arms and the boots onto the legs. Then, decorate the legs with little strips of paper.

5. Glue the arms onto the cone and glue the legs inside, at the front. Cut a piece of thread and make a loop for hanging, then tape it onto the back of the cone.

179 Elf

Make one of Santa's elves with green paper. Draw a face with pointed ears.



180 Girl elf

Make a girl elf with long hair glued onto the face.



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Snowman

Cut a circle for a head and glue it onto a cone. Cut a piece of thread and make a loop for hanging, then tape it onto the back of the cone.



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Angel

Make a cone from pink paper and cover it with a tissue paper snowflake (see page 88). Tape wings to the back of the cone.



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Christmas tree

Glue crêpe paper onto a semicircle of paper. Decorate the tree with sequins, ribbon and a star.



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Reindeer

Cut out a head and antlers and glue them onto the top of a cone. Add a red nose, fur on its tummy and hooves.



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
