DICE DOGS

Players take turns rolling a dice and drawing the part of a dog that corresponds to the number rolled.

Each player must throw a...

☆ 6 for the dog's body


\$ 5 for each ear

☆ 4 for each eye

☆ 3 for each lea

☆ 2 for its tail

\$ 1 for its head



You must draw its body first, and then its head (so you need to throw a 6 to start, then a 1). Then, you can draw the other parts in any order.



The winner is the first person to draw a complete dog.

BEE TAKEAWAY

This is a two-player game. When it's your turn, cross out as many bees as you like - but only from one of the four rows. The winner is the person who forces the loser to cross out the last remaining bee.























To play this game again, draw four more rows of bees, or four rows of

circles, on some paper.




FUNNY FIGURES
