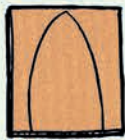
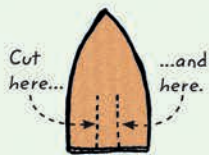


Curious cats

143 Simple cat



1. Draw a body on a piece of cardboard.



2. For the legs, make two cuts like this.



3. Fold the middle part forward for paws, then fold the other parts back.



4. Cut out a cardboard head and glue it on. Then, add ears and a tail.



5. Use chalks or pastels to fill in the head, ears, body and tail.



6. Glue on paper eyes and whiskers. Then, draw a nose and mouth.



144 Cleaning cat

Make just one cut on the body so that there's only one paw. Cut out a curved paw and glue it onto the back of the body. Glue on a small pink tongue, too.

Draw 'u' shapes for closed eyes.



145 Kitten

Follow the same technique, but make a much smaller body, head and tail.

146 Ginger tom

Fill in the cat with a dark orange pastel, then use a paler orange to draw lots of lines on top.

147 Fluffy tummy

Smudge a patch of white pastel onto the cat's body. Then, draw lots of short lines on top.
