

Pretty masks

90 Basic mask



1. Lay a pair of your glasses or sunglasses onto a piece of thick paper or thin cardboard. Then, draw around the glasses carefully with a pencil.



2. Draw two shapes where your eyes will go. Then, draw the shape of a mask around the outline of the glasses. Cut around the outside of the mask.



3. Press the point of a sharp pencil through one eye hole. Then, push scissors into the hole and cut out the eye hole. Cut out the other one, too.



4. Bend the top of a bendy straw and tape it on as a handle.



91 Harlequin mask

Decorate a mask with paper diamonds and glitter glue.

92 Glittery masks

Decorate a mask with glitter and shiny stickers.

93 Curly decorations

Glue on gift ribbon and press a shiny sticker on top.

Animal masks

Tape elastic or string to the back of any of these masks to wear them.

94 Tiger mask

Make a tiger mask with diamond-shaped eyes.

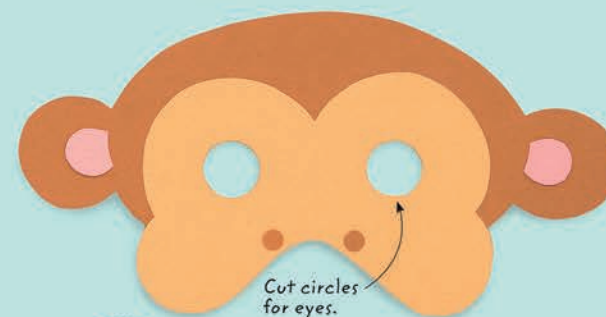


Use orange paper and draw stripes with a black felt-tip pen.



95 Cat mask

Make a cat mask. Decorate it with sequins and shapes cut from paper.



Cut circles for eyes.

97 Monkey mask

Cut out a monkey head and face from brown paper. Use pink paper for the ears.

Cut these shapes for the monkey and bird masks.

98 Bird mask

Cut feathers from tissue paper and glue them around the mask.



96 Butterfly mask

Cut out butterfly wings and cut circles in them for your eyes. Add gift ribbon feelers.
