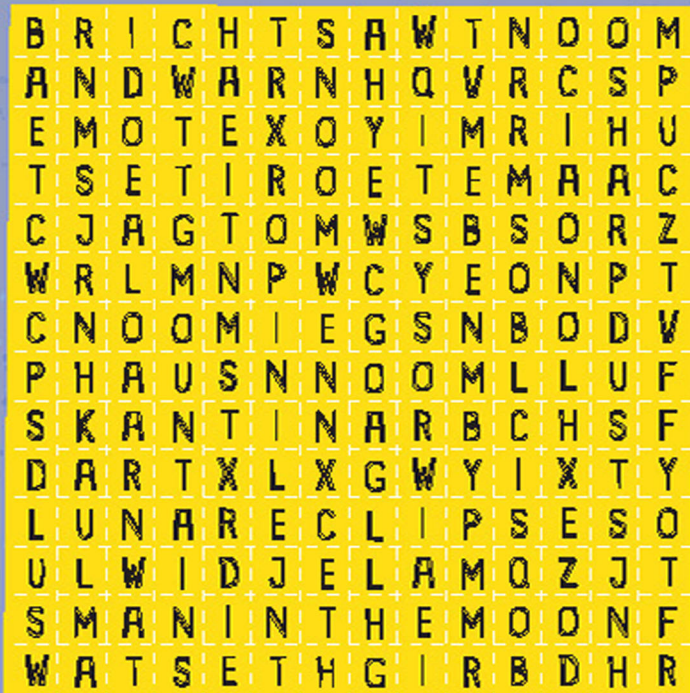


THE MOON

As it orbits, our Moon keeps one side facing us. It seems to grow (wax) or shrink (wane) as sunlight hits it at different angles.



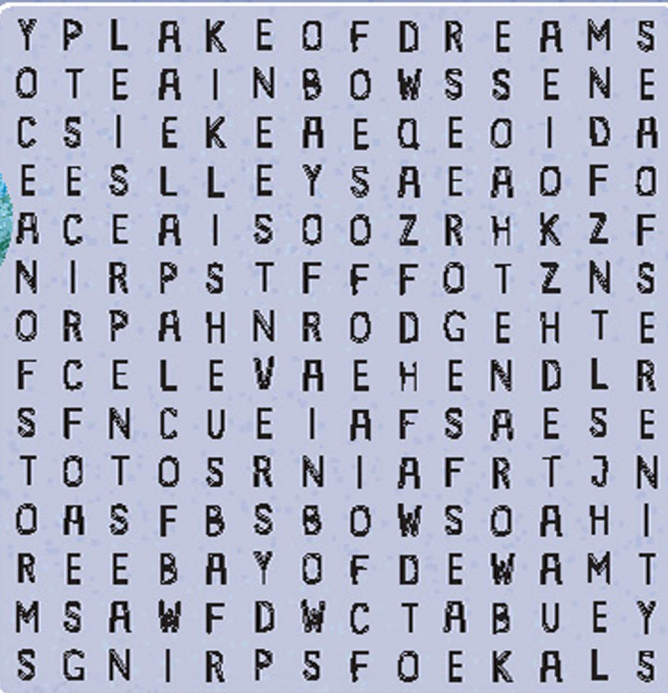

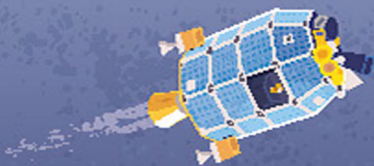
Pale, rocky higher ground on the Moon's surface is broken up by dark plains of old lava with watery names like the Sea of Rains.
