

# PAPER BAG SAFARI

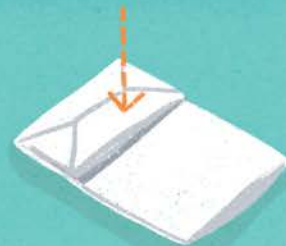
Turn paper bags into different types of wild animals by cutting out shapes from paper and gluing them onto the bags. Just follow the steps and ideas on the next three pages...

**BEFORE YOU DECORATE EACH BAG...**

Cut off any handles...



...and press the base flat to make the face.



## ZEBRA

Cut out two pointed arch shapes for **EARS**.

Add a pink teardrop shape in the middle.

To give your zebra a spiky **MANE**, snip slits into a wedge shape and stick it onto the back.

Cut out a big oval for its **MUZZLE**. Then use a black felt-tip pen to draw two nostrils and a mouth.

For each **EYE**, draw or stick a black spot on top of a white circle.

Curved strips for **STRIPES**
