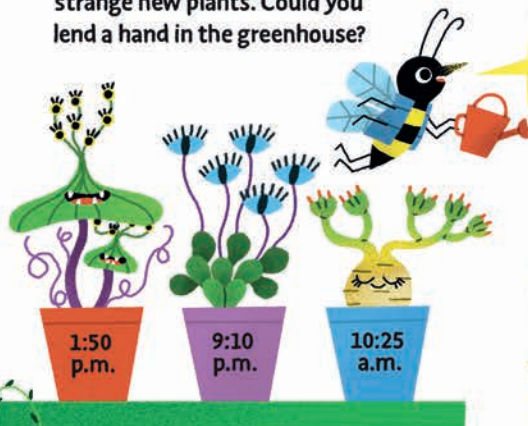


# PECULIAR BLOOMS

The Brainy Bees are creating strange new plants. Could you lend a hand in the greenhouse?

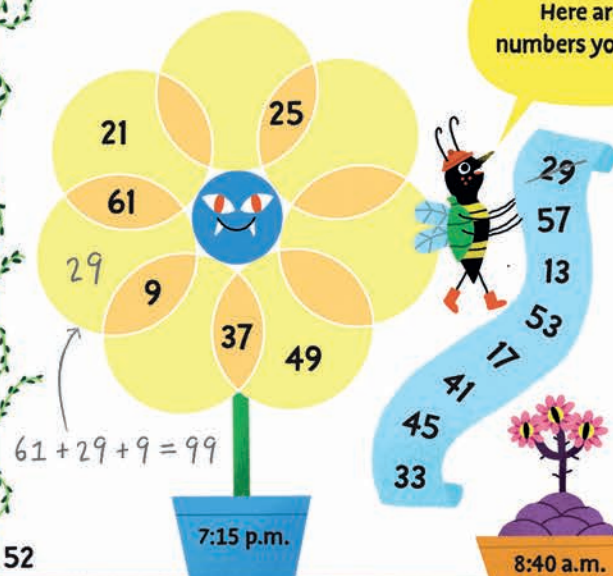


Each plant has its own watering time. I work from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Can you look at both pages and circle the plants I'll need to water?

Here are the numbers you'll need.

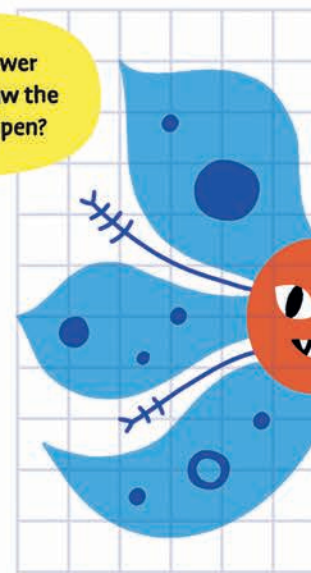


## BRAIN BOOSTER

Doing things by hand – whether gardening or writing – helps engage your brain, making it easier to remember things.



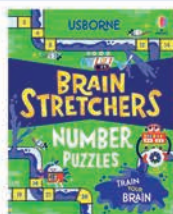
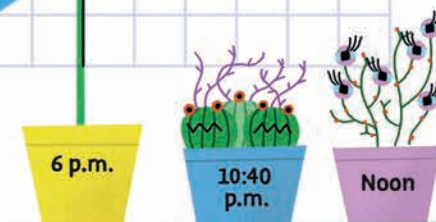
Only HALF of this flower has opened. Can you draw the other half so it's fully open?
