

IN THE SHADOWS

Shadow show

1. Shine a spotlight onto a white wall. Make sure all the other lights in the room are switched off.

2. Make shapes with your hands in front of the light to cast shadows onto the wall.

Try making these animal-shaped shadows with your hands:

Flap your hands to see the bird beat its wings.



Open and close your little fingers to make the dog bark.



Flick your fingers to bend the elephant's trunk.



Put two strips of paper between your fingers to make the snake's tongue.



Make the rabbit's ears twitch by wiggling your fingers.



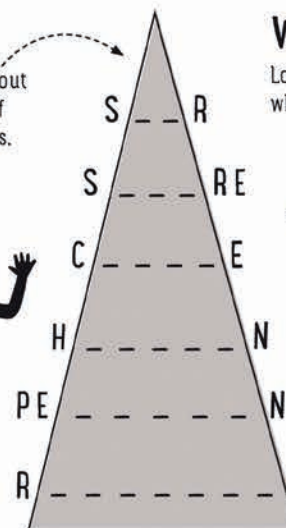
Snap your hands - or the crocodile's mouth - shut.

A triangular shadow is blocking out some of the letters in this list of shapes. Fill in the missing letters.

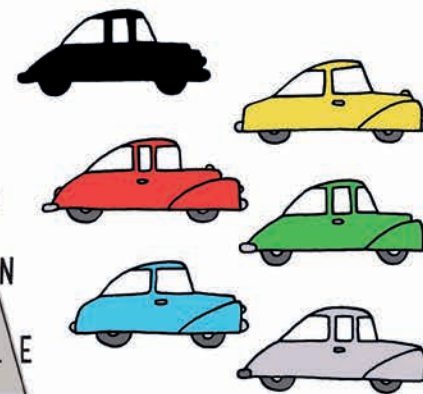
Did you know?

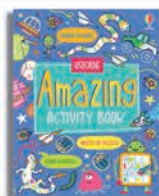
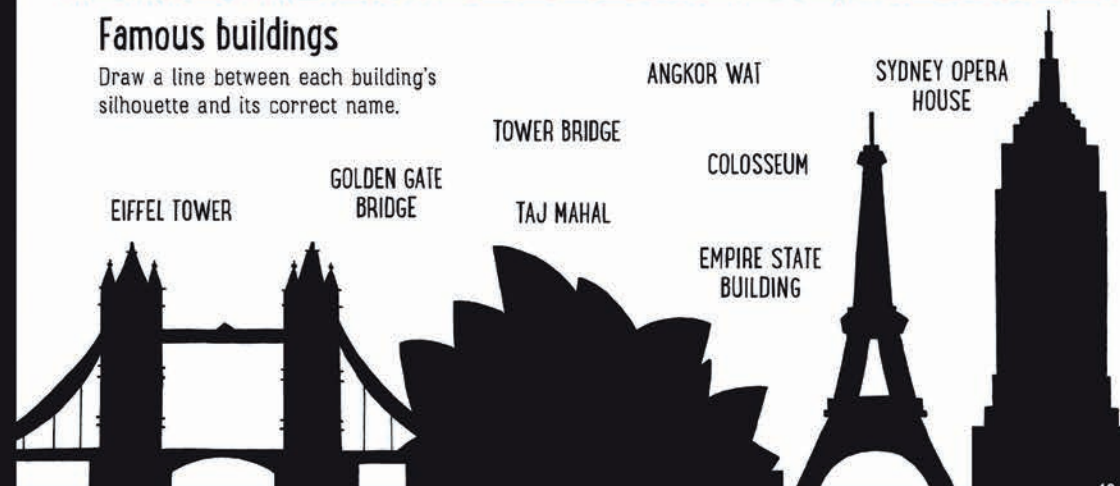
