

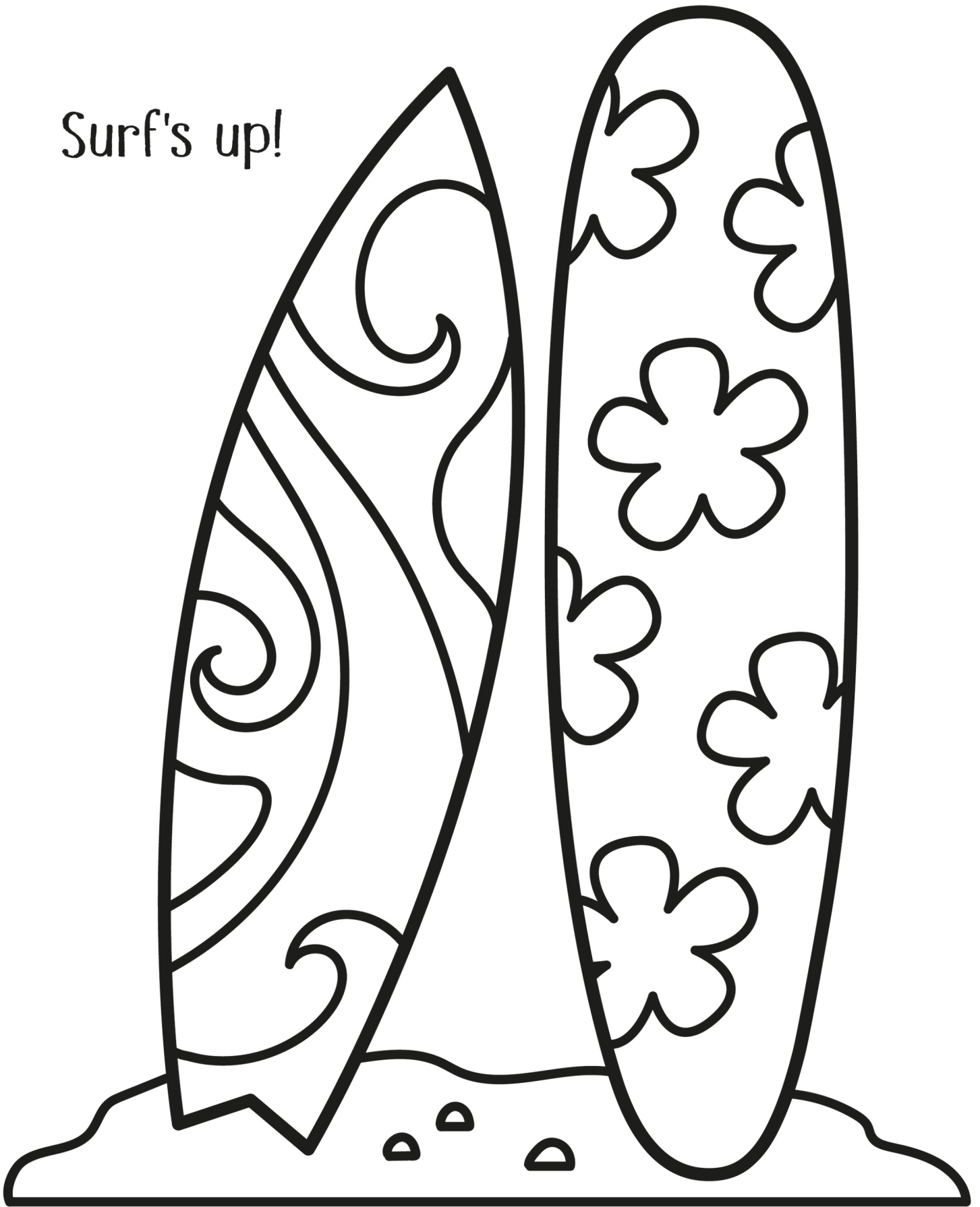

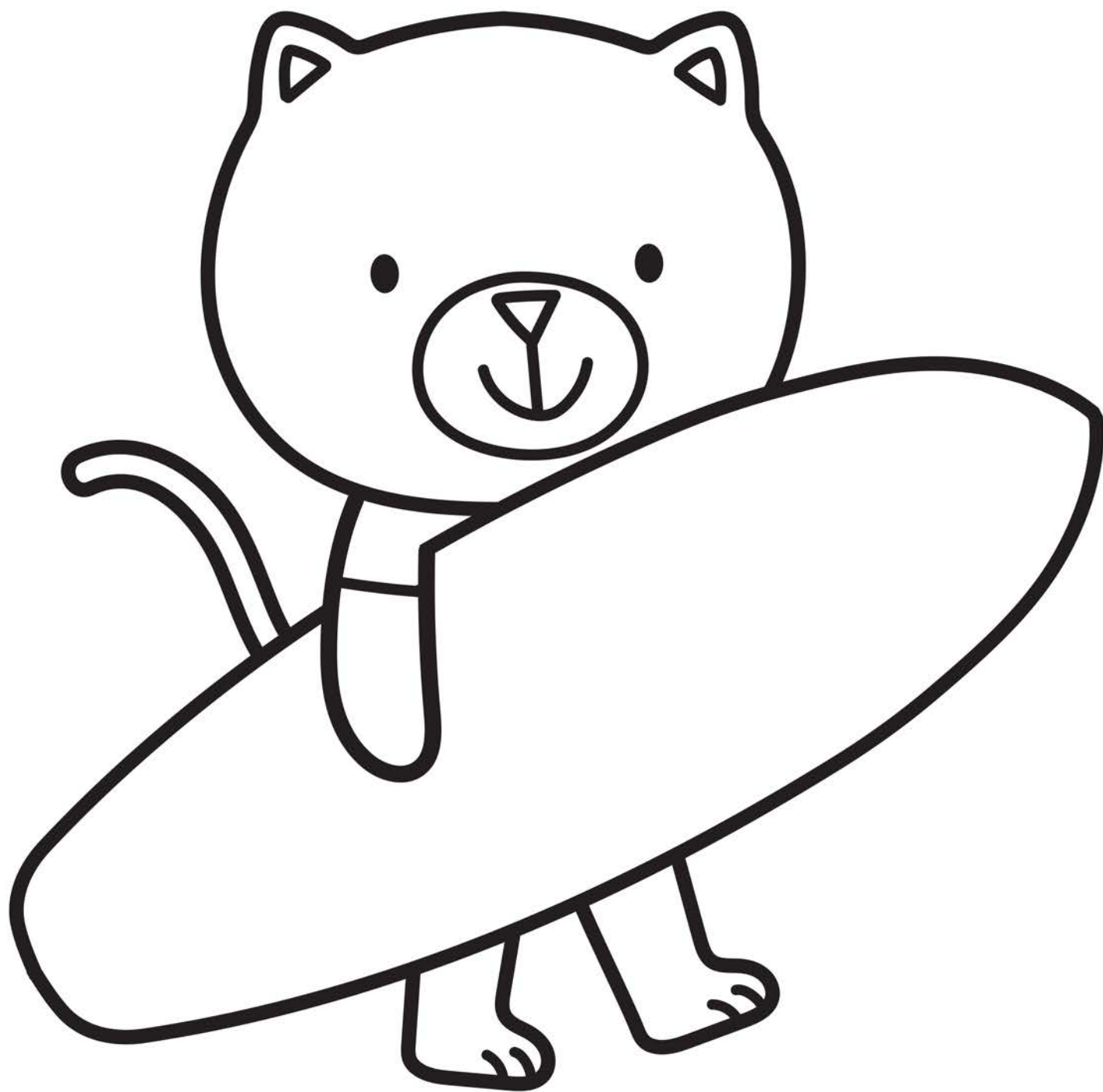

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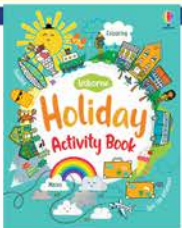
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Paige, Kyle, Kunal and Tim have \$40 between them for a surfing lesson. How long a lesson will they be able to have?



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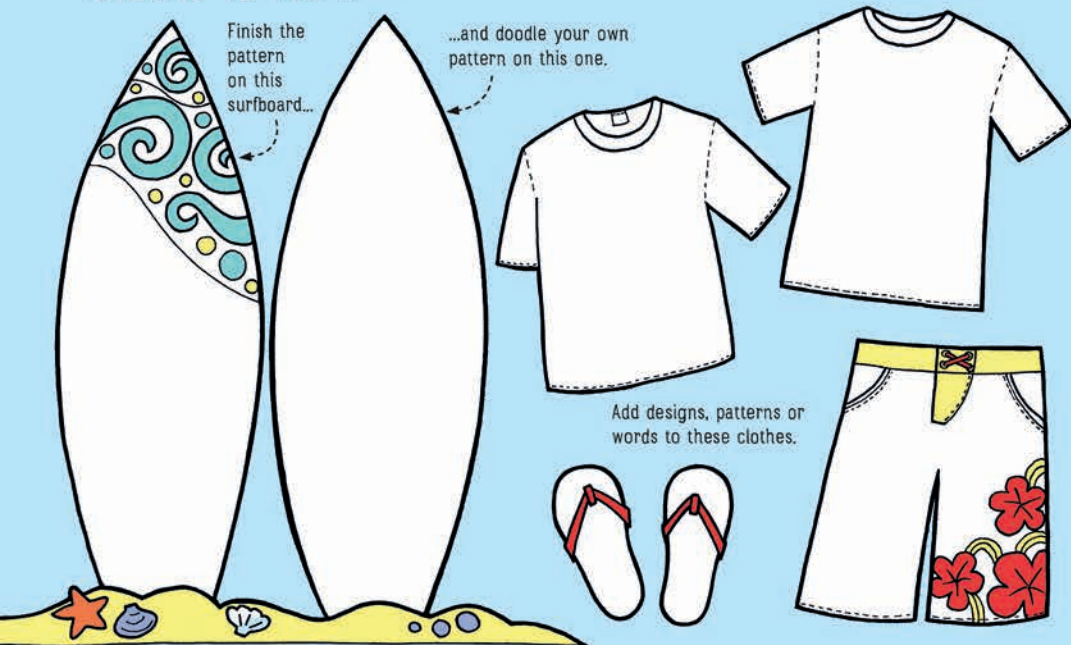

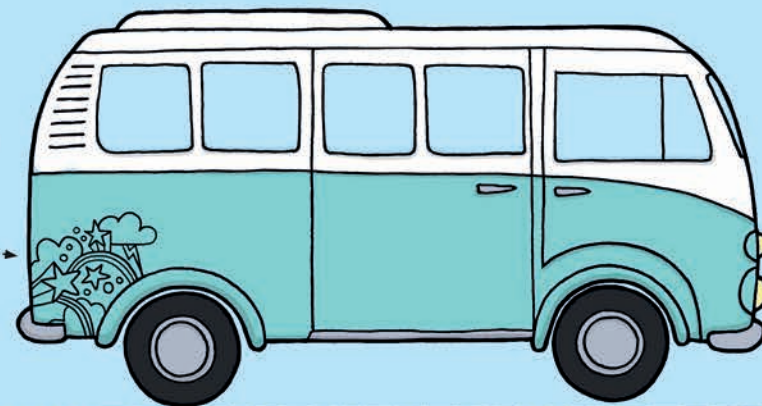
SURF'S UP!

Surfer talk

Surfing has a language of its own. Here are some surfing words:

- ☆ Set - group of waves.
- ☆ Lip - crest of a breaking wave.
- ☆ Barrel - space inside the curve of a breaking wave.
- ☆ Glassy - windless conditions, when the sea's surface is very smooth.
- ☆ Rail - edge (side) of a surfboard.
- ☆ Wipe-out - when someone falls off a surfboard as they're surfing a wave.



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
