



# Noisy oceans

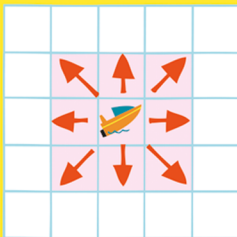

Noise from the red ferries travels two squares in every direction.

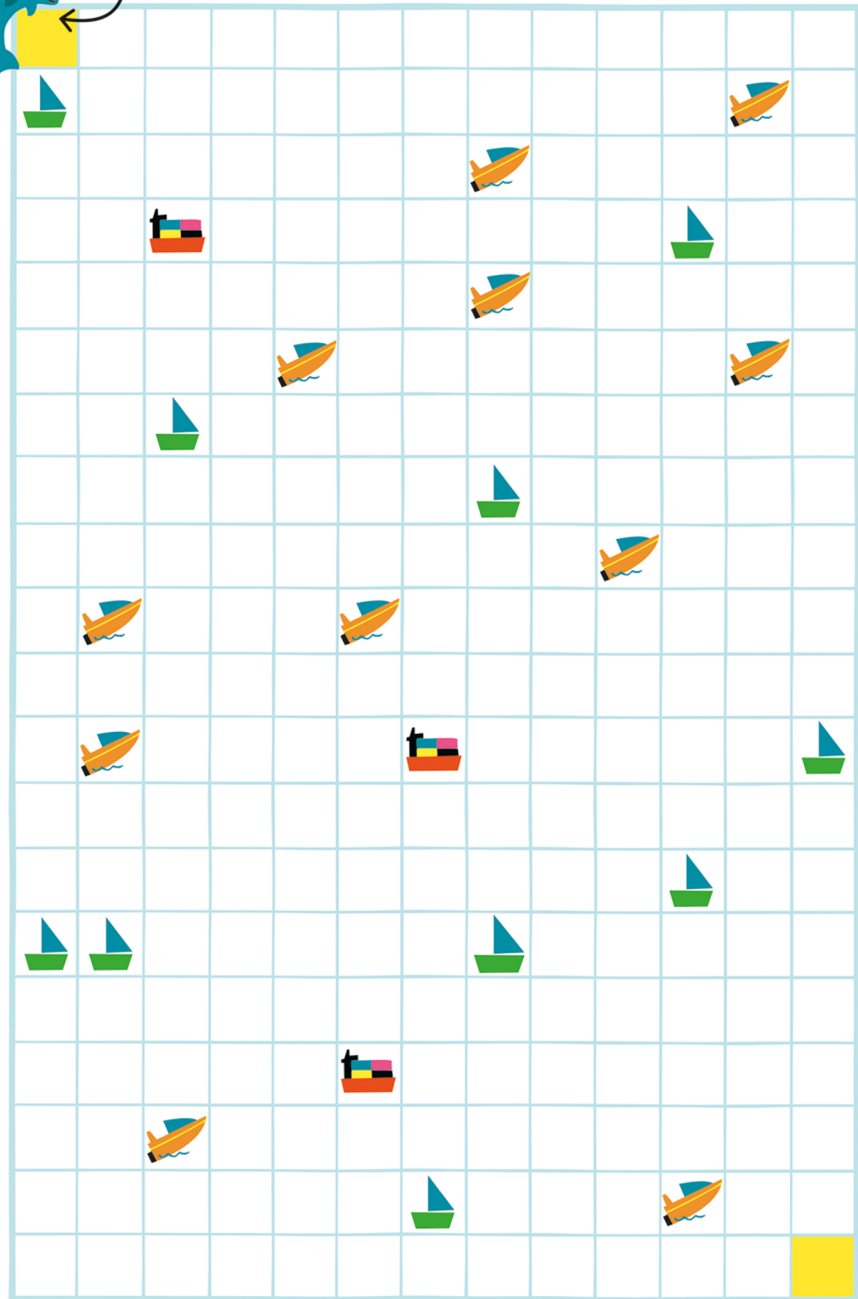
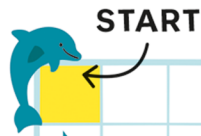
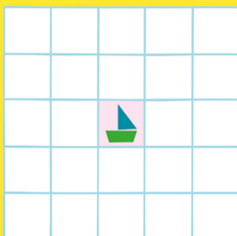


Noise from the orange speedboats travels one square in every direction.

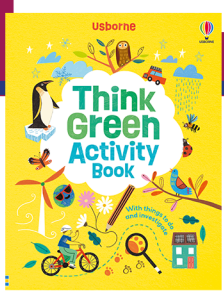


Noise from the green boats doesn't travel outside each square.
