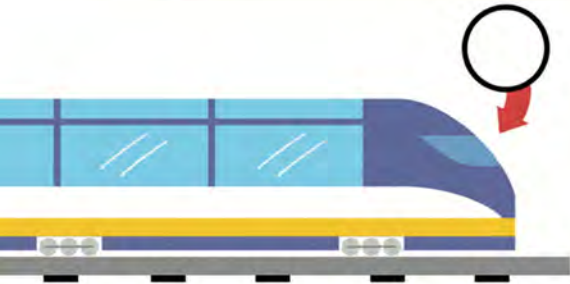


# TOP TRAINS

Decorated with pictures of clouds, this train climbs its way into the foothills of the Andes mountains.

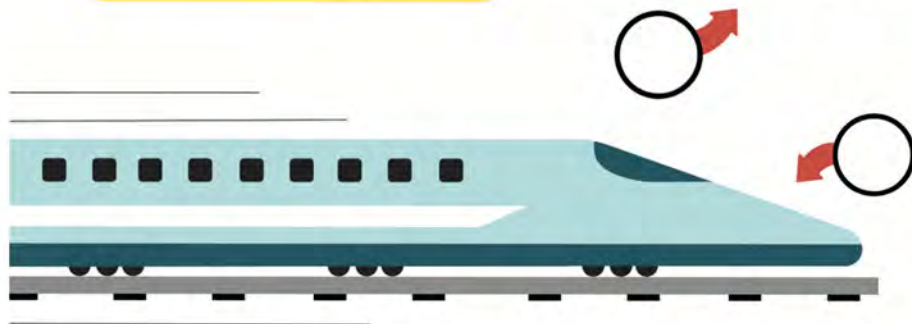
## 3. ROCKY MOUNTAINEER

This type of train has no wheels. It uses strong magnets to hover along tracks.

## 6. THE BLUE TRAIN

The windows of this luxury passenger train have gold frames.
