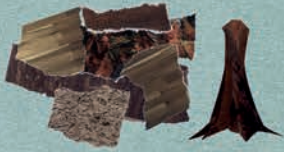


Windy tree collage

133 Paper tree



1. Rip pages from old magazines that are shades of brown. Then, cut out a shape for a tree trunk.



2. Glue the trunk onto some paper. Then, cut out lots of branches and glue them on so they overlap.



3. Cut leaves from the different pieces of magazine paper and glue them around the branches.



136 Windy sky

Draw swirls on your paper with a black chalk pastel and smudge it with a fingertip. Then, draw a line along it with an eraser.

135 A crow

Cut out a body from black paper and glue it onto your picture. Add a paper eye and beak. Draw a pupil in the eye, a wing and tail feathers.

Falling leaves

Glue some leaves tumbling down from a tree. Add some on the ground beneath the tree, too.

The ground in this picture is made with lots of shapes overlapping each other.

You could add a crow searching for food.
