
Plotting points

A **vertex** is a point where two or more lines meet, such as a corner. The corners of a polygon are called **vertices**.





The animals have traced shapes in the ice for a skating competition. Use Dilly's set of coordinates to plot the vertices of her shape on the opposite grid. Once her vertices are plotted, draw lines to join them up and reveal the shape.

(7,3)(9,3)(9,5)




(4, 1) (5, 0) (7, 1)
