

Symmetry

When both halves of a shape are the same, the shape is symmetrical. You can divide a symmetrical shape in half with a mirror line, or line of symmetry, like this:



These three friends have drawn a vertical mirror line on the grid below. Each of them has drawn half a shape along it. Draw the other half of their shapes for them, so that each shape is symmetrical.
