


## Watch out for y!

You usually add the letter  $\mathbf{s}$  to make a word plural. But if a word ends in  $\mathbf{y}$ , you sometimes need to make more spelling changes.



singular	plura

story	stories

The rule for changing **y to ies** works for verbs too. Draw a line through the words you think are wrong.

Then she drys/dries her eyes and says/saies, "I need some fruit!"



Singular means just one of something. Plural means more than one.
