

Cut-paper star card



1. Cut a rectangle and two smaller rectangles from paper or thin cardboard. Use a different shade of paper for each rectangle.



2. For the card itself, cut a rectangle of paper and fold it in half. Then, glue the largest rectangle on top and trim the edges.



3. Glue the smallest rectangle of paper onto the back of a piece of shiny paper or giftwrap. Then, trim around it.



4. Using a craft knife, carefully cut several lines that cross each other near the top of the paper. Then, push a pencil through the cuts.



5. Gently fold each triangle back. Crease the folds well, so that the shiny paper makes a star shape on the front of the paper, like this.



6. Glue both paper rectangles onto the card, with the small one on top. Draw a pattern in the star with gold pen, then glue on gold paper shapes.
