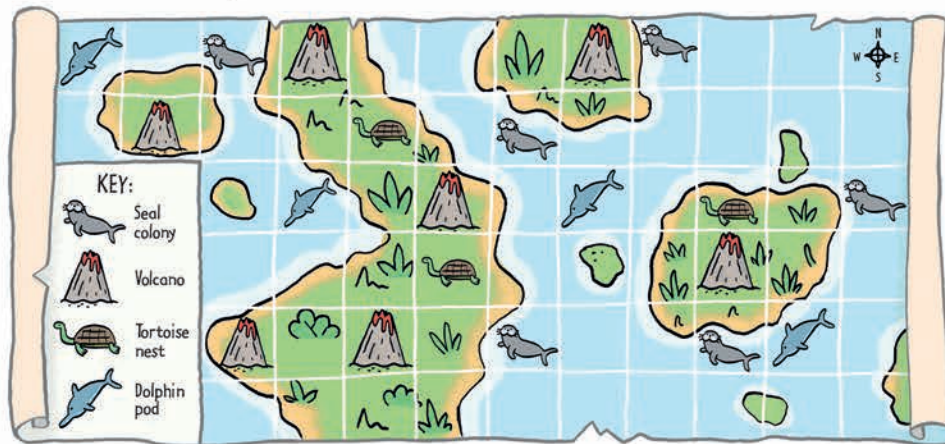


GREAT EXPLORERS

FIND A NEW SPECIES

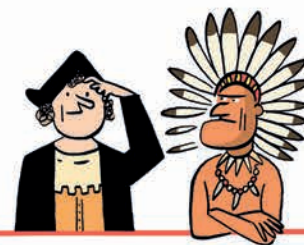
One of these Galapagos animals is a new species and doesn't appear in the identification book. Pair up the animals with the ones in the book, to find out which is the new species.
