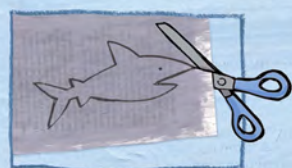


# Newspaper Sharks

1. Cover a sheet of newspaper with paint, so that some of the lettering shows through.



2. When the paint is dry, draw a simple shark shape and cut it out.

You could make a big picture with lots of things swimming in the sea.

Draw a row of zigzag teeth along the top of a shark's open mouth.

184

Cut fish from scraps of painted newspaper and glue them around a shark.

185

Copy this shape for a hammerhead shark. Draw two eyes on its head.

Cut out a squid with long, wavy tentacles and add it between some sharks.

These sharks, fish and squid were glued onto a piece of painted newspaper.
