

Origami peace dove

Around the world, doves are a symbol of peace, freedom and love. To make your own dove, take a square of white paper and follow these steps.




The dotted lines show where to make the folds.

way, to make a triangle.


The solid lines show where a fold has already been made.




3. Fold over the point of


the triangle.

4. Then fold back part of the top layer so it looks like step 5.







make two angled wings.
