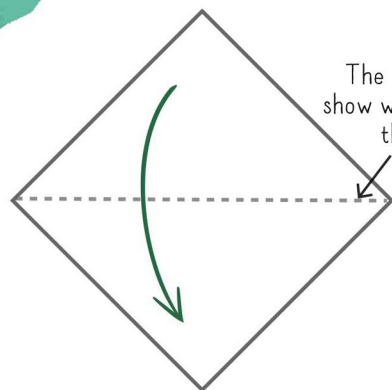


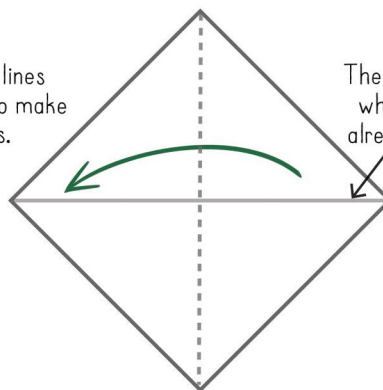
# Origami peace dove

Around the world, doves are a symbol of peace, freedom and love.  
To make your own dove, take a square of white paper and follow these steps.



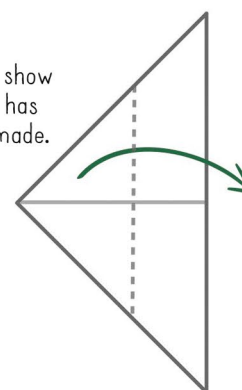
1. Fold and unfold the paper square.

The dotted lines show where to make the folds.

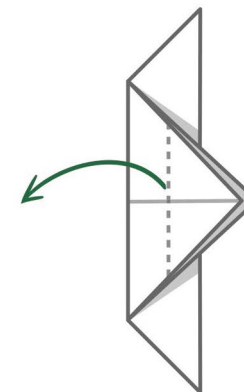


2. Fold it in half the other way, to make a triangle.

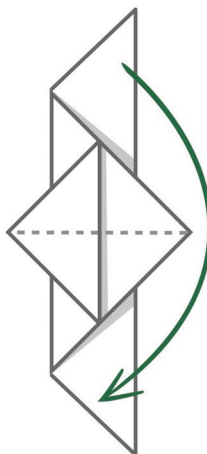
The solid lines show where a fold has already been made.



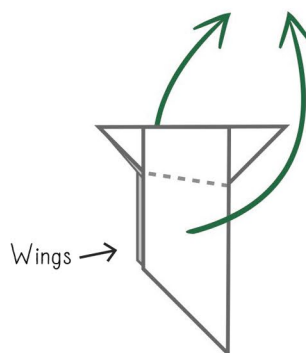
3. Fold over the point of the triangle.



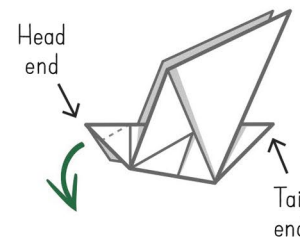
4. Then fold back part of the top layer so it looks like step 5.



5. Now fold in half lengthways.

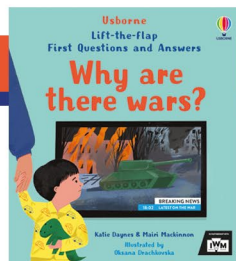
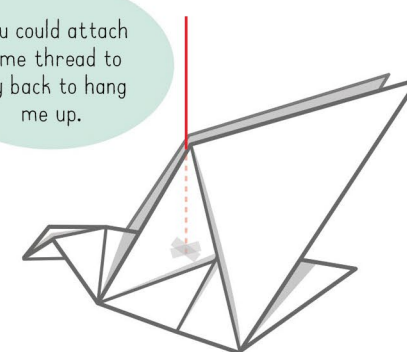


6. Fold back each length to make two angled wings.



7. Lastly, tuck in the point at the head end and crease it to make a beak.

You could attach some thread to my back to hang me up.
