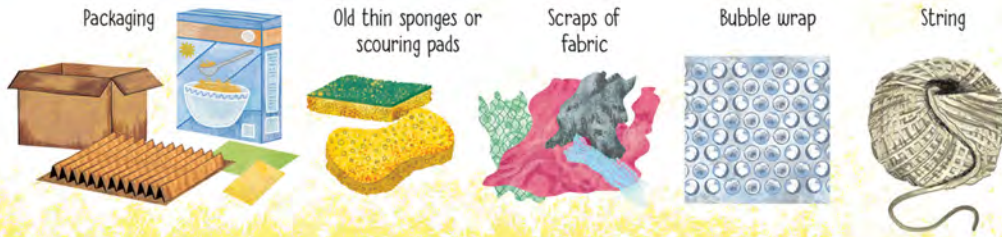


STICK AND PRINT FLOWERS

If you cut out shapes from different materials and stick them onto a piece of cardboard, you can use it to print pictures.

1 Choose materials for your shapes – the more types of textures they have, the better:



2 Cut out shapes for flowers, stems and leaves, like the ones on this page.



3 Arrange the shapes on the piece of cardboard (see right), then glue them down.

You can also stick shapes on top of shapes.

4 Now paint a layer of craft glue all over the cardboard and shapes to make them waterproof. Wait for the glue to dry.

Now print...

The picture you print will be a mirror image of the different shapes.

Use an old sponge to cover the top of the cardboard and all the shapes in poster paint.

Press the painted side carefully onto a piece of paper.



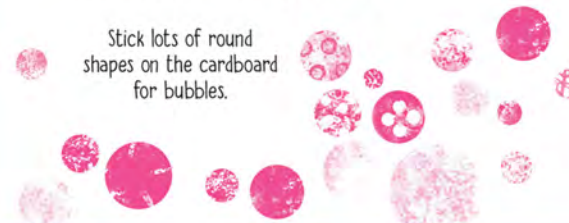

Slowly lift up the cardboard to reveal your picture.

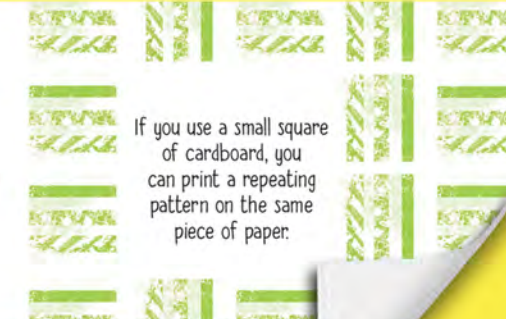


You can print again and again with the same piece of cardboard. Just wait for it to dry, before you add a new layer of paint.

More printing ideas



Stick lots of round shapes on the cardboard for bubbles.



If you use a small square of cardboard, you can print a repeating pattern on the same piece of paper.
