"No idea," said Jade. "But I think it has something to do with this book."

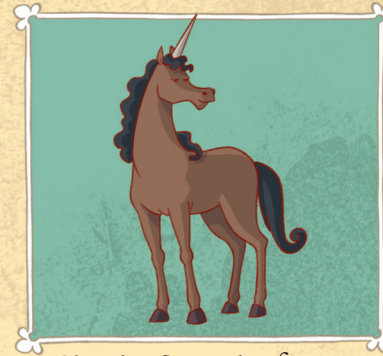

Ye Book of Unicorns



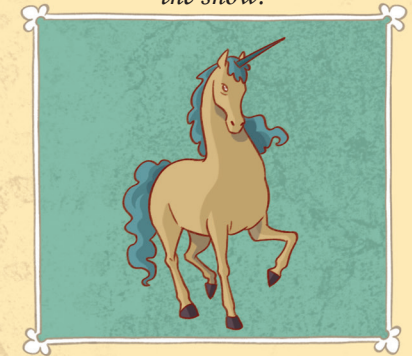
Ye Isle of Myrtle Unicorn
