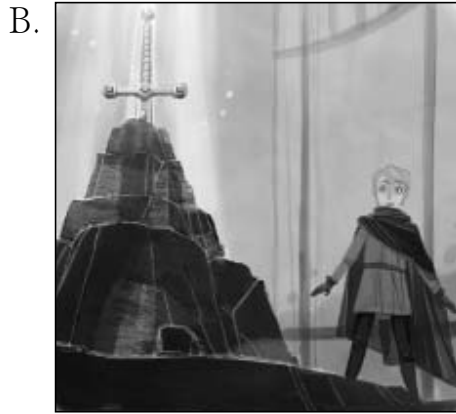

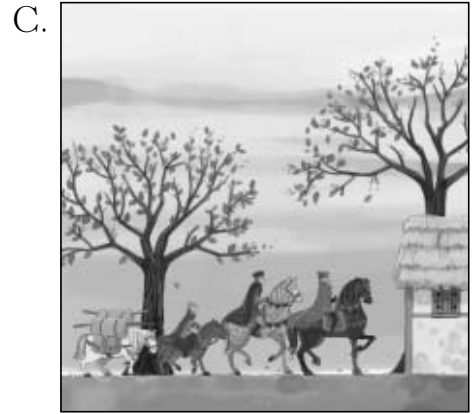
Can you put these pictures and sentences in order?

Kay and Arthur grew up in the country.



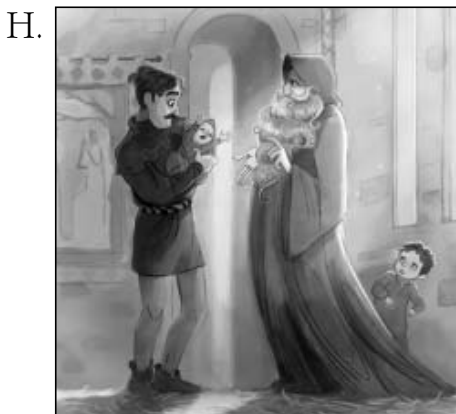
The sword came out easily.

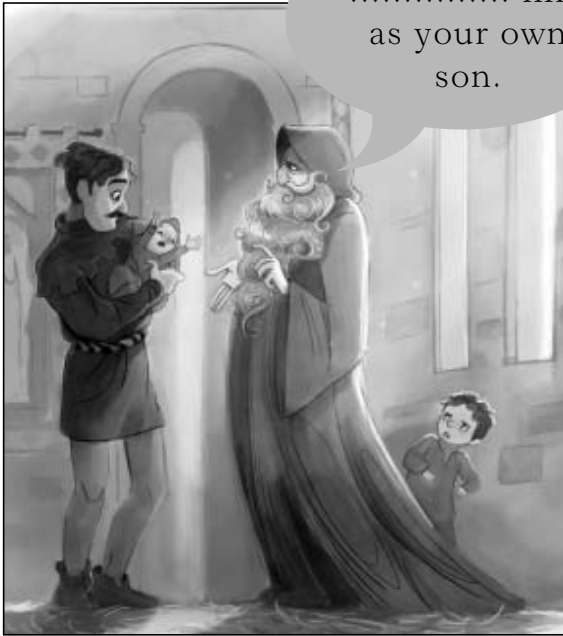

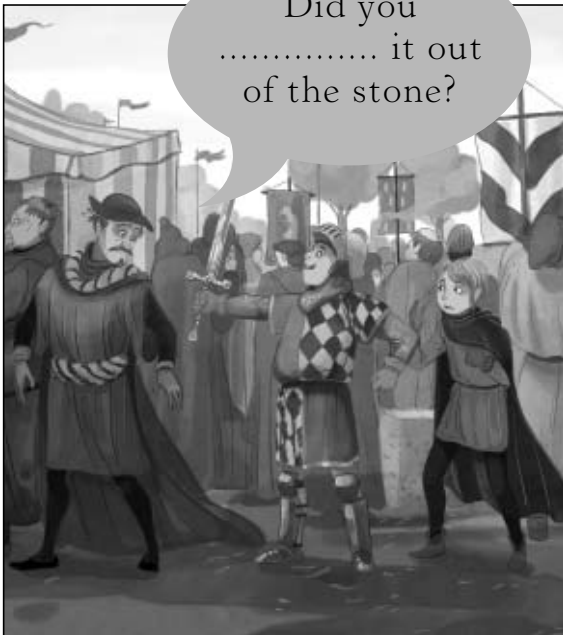

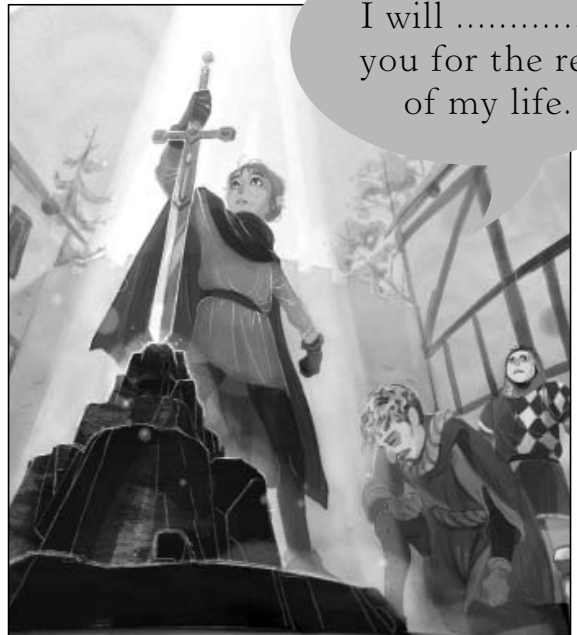
