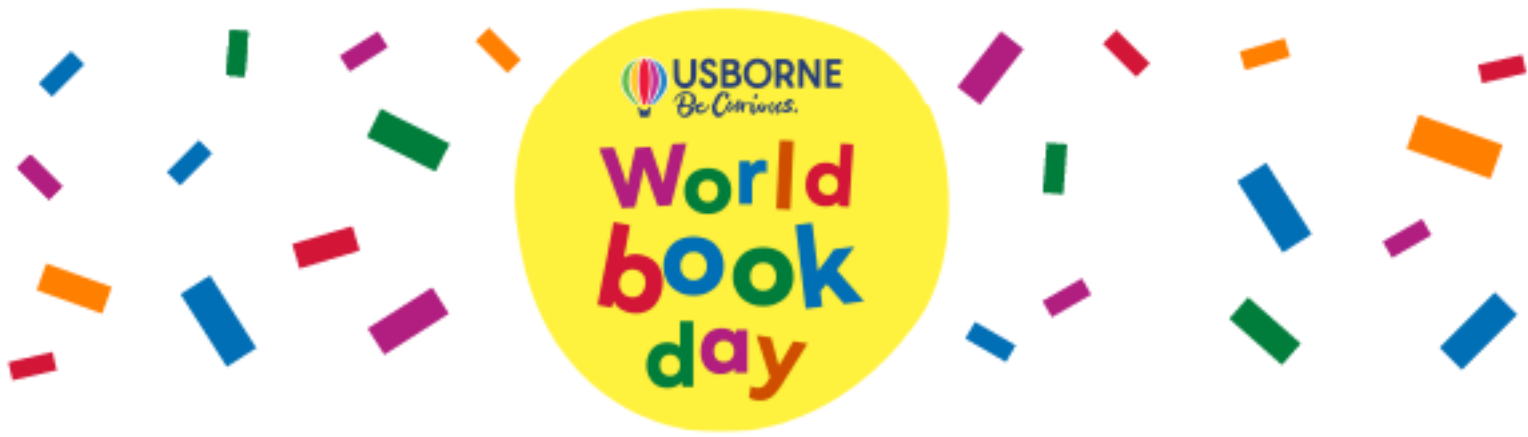




Interview a Character

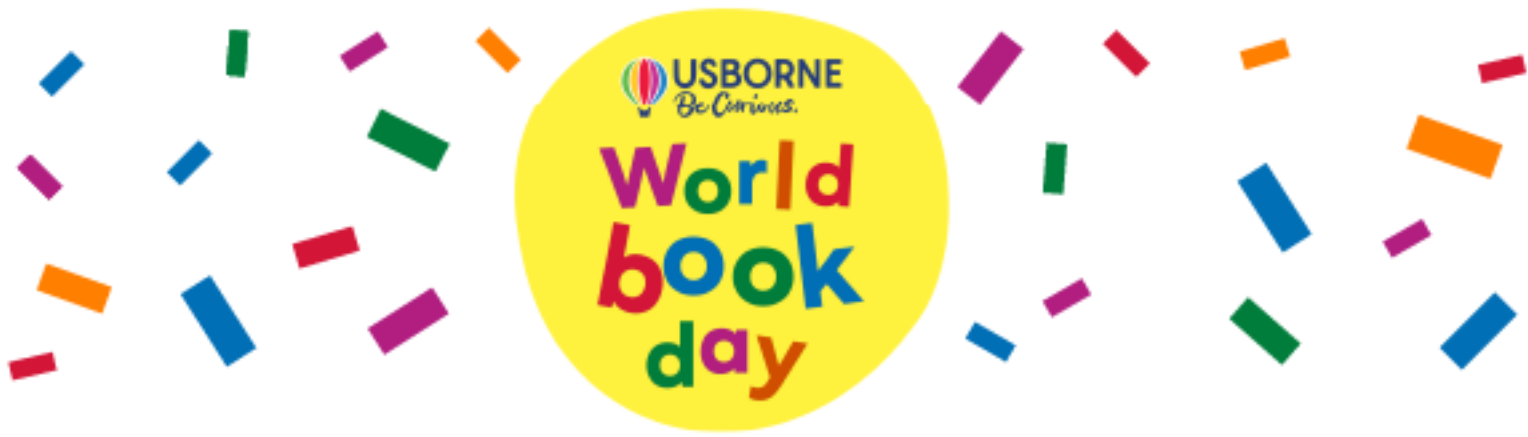
Think about something that happened to your character during the book. What would you like to know more about?
